Nestled in a valley against the 3.3 million acre Gila National Forest, Silver City is equal parts Old West heritage and a distinctive arts and entertainment community. Boasting historical ties with Billy the Kid, the Gila Cliff Dwellings, and Geronimo, as well as the third largest open pit copper mine in the world, Silver City shines in its artistic, culinary, and historical offerings. The downtown Historic District boasts more than a dozen restaurants, murals, and some thirty-plus galleries and artist studios. Silver City is no New Mexico desert town; at 6,000 feet, the summer monsoons enliven the lush landscape and provide an escape from the typical Southwestern heat. The climate is noted for its clear mountain air, low humidity, and four gentle seasons. With a population of a little under 10,000, Silver City is the idyllic American small mountain town.
